After graduating from Penn Dental School in 1981, Dr. Ganzberg was dual trained in Anesthesiology and Orofacial Pain with board certifications in both fields. He taught and later directed the Dental Anesthesiology Residency at Ohio State for 17 years before coming to UCLA. Dr. Ganzberg is a past president of the American Society of Dentist Anesthesiologists and the American Dental Board of Anesthesiology. Currently, he provides anesthesia for dento-alveolar, maxillofacial and facial plastic surgery. He has published over 50 original research articles and book chapters in the field.
